

GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS Version 01.09.2024

Art. 1 - Publisher of NAPOLEONDICE

The publisher of NAPOLEONDICE is the following company:

Napoleon Games NV is a public limited company under Belgian law, with its registered office at Gentsesteenweg 505, 1080 Molenbeek, registered in the Crossroads Bank for Enterprises under number 0424.851.684. Napoleon Games NV holds a B license under Belgian law for the operation of offline games of chance in a Class II gaming establishment and an additional B+ license under Belgian law for the operation of games of chance via information society instruments.

Hereinafter referred to as "Napoleon Games NV."

Art. 2 - Definitions

Visitor

A Visitor is any natural person who wishes to register to use the services offered on NAPOLEONDICE.

Cash Player

A Cash Player is a Player who participates in services via NAPOLEONDICE with a monetary Stake.

Customer Service

Customer Service is the service via NAPOLEONDICE where every Visitor/Player can obtain further information or assistance. This service is also available on www.napoleongames.be.

Free Player

A Free Player is a Player who participates in services via NAPOLEONDICE without monetary Stake.

Stake

The Stake is the total of financial resources, of any kind, that the Player exposes to the risk of the Game.

Game of Chance

A Game of Chance is any game in which an introduced Stake of any kind, either the loss of this Stake by at least one of the Players, or a Gain of any kind for at least one of the Players or organizers of the game results, and in which chance plays even a secondary role in the course of the game, the designation of the winner, or the determination of the amount of the gain. Notwithstanding the preceding paragraph, games may also be played on NAPOLEONDICE that contain all elements of a Game of Chance as described above but for which no stake is required. Notwithstanding this distinction, these games are also considered as Games of Chance under these Terms unless explicitly stated otherwise.

NAPOLEONDICE

'NAPOLEONDICE' refers to the online platform on which a set of services is offered by the Company or one or more services provided by the Company via information society instruments. This includes but is not limited to www.napoleondice.be, social media, and mobile applications.

Game

A Game is a Game of Chance offered on NAPOLEONDICE.

Player

A Player is any Visitor who, after valid registration and verification of registration details, uses the services via NAPOLEONDICE.

Player Account

A Player Account is the set of personal registration details, registration data, and Player account that allow the Player to use the services on NAPOLEONDICE.

Player Account Balance

A Player Account Balance is a personal account of a Player on NAPOLEONDICE on which funds can be credited and debited.

Game Rules

The Game Rules are the set of rules applicable to the specific Game.

Game Session

A Game Session is the period between the start and end of a Game, during which one or more Game Rounds can be played.

Game Round

A Game Round is the period from the start of the Game Round (if no Stake is required) or from the Stake to the result of the Game.

Company

The Company is Napoleon Games NV and, where relevant, its affiliated companies.

Competition

A game in a narrower sense where no Stake is required, and participants can influence the outcome through their artistic, physical, or intellectual skills, without necessarily excluding an element of chance. The prize may be awarded in the form of financial means, physical prizes, or otherwise as specified in the relevant competition conditions.

Gain

The Gain is the total of financial resources received by the Player at the end of the Game Round.

Art. 3 - Offered Services

The Company offers its Players a legally permitted online gaming experience via NAPOLEONDICE in accordance with current regulations. The offer consists of:

Games of Chance

Only games with a Stake can be played.

However, games that contain all elements of a Game of Chance but for which no Stake is required can also be played. Notwithstanding this distinction, these games are also considered Games of Chance for the application of these Terms unless explicitly stated otherwise.

Competitions

Only games without a Stake can be played.

Everything necessary or useful to allow the Player to participate in Games of Chance and/or Competitions and/or any other offer, and in general everything necessary or useful for the operation of NAPOLEONDICE.

Art. 4 - General

Access to and use of NAPOLEONDICE is subject to these general terms and conditions

(hereinafter referred to as "Terms"). By explicitly accepting the Terms when creating a Player Account as well as when logging in with the Player Account in case new Terms have been created and thus prior to participating in any Game of Chance or Competition, each Visitor explicitly, unconditionally, and irrevocably agrees that he/she as well as his/her successors are bound by these Terms, to the exclusion of all others. These Terms also include:

The Game Rules that specifically apply to the individual Games offered on NAPOLEONDICE or the rules applicable to any other offer on NAPOLEONDICE that form an integral part thereof and with which every Player explicitly agrees by playing such Game or any other offer, as well as the rules applicable to Competitions, and which the Player can review before actual participation in the Game, any other offer, or Competition.

The Company reserves the right to modify these Terms, as described above, the access to and content of NAPOLEONDICE, as well as the rules applicable to any offer on NAPOLEONDICE at any time and in any manner without prior notice. In case of a change to these Terms, except for (i) the Game Rules linked to individual Games, (ii) the rules applicable to any other offer on NAPOLEONDICE, or (iii) the rules applicable to Competitions, the Players will be notified at the next login to NAPOLEONDICE. Such changes must be explicitly accepted by each Player who wishes to continue using the services on NAPOLEONDICE.

The fact that the Company does not invoke a provision of these Terms at any given time cannot be interpreted as a waiver of any right or provision.

If the Company allows a deviation from these Terms to a separate Player on an exceptional and personal basis, this can never be considered an acquired right by the Player in question.

Art. 5 - Registration

Registration on NAPOLEONDICE is only permitted for natural persons who are legally competent and at least 21 years old. Each individual is entitled to a maximum of one Player Account on NAPOLEONDICE. If the Company reasonably suspects or discovers that a single person directly or indirectly controls multiple Player Accounts, regardless of whether the Player is acting in bad faith or not, the Company expressly reserves the right to block any Player Account whose details do not match the actual identification details of the person and to block any funds present in these accounts, without the Player being able to claim any rights to them. The Company also reserves the right to take further legal action, including filing a criminal complaint.

The Player Account is strictly personal, may not be transferred to a third party, and may not be used by any third party. Each Player is responsible for providing truthful, complete, accurate, and up-to-date information. The Company reserves the right to verify the accuracy of this information at any time and in any way.

To register validly, the procedure described below must be followed. The Visitor must provide the following mandatory details: national identification number (or equivalent), first and last name (as stated on the identity card), gender, date of birth, place of birth, address, postal code, city of residence, nationality, telephone number, email address, username, occupation, and password.

The telephone number can be modified by the Player at any time, provided a verification procedure is followed. All other details can only be changed with the express intervention of the Company's Customer Service department, provided they match the relevant identification documents. The Company reserves the right to unilaterally prohibit the use of a particular username or password if it deems it inappropriate or contrary to public order or morality.

In case of loss, theft, or forgetting of the Player Account and/or associated data or any other relevant information specific to the Player, the Player must immediately contact Customer Service. After verifying the identity, the Company will take all necessary measures to restore access to the Player's Account and/or all other relevant data.

Each Player confirms that they will not in any way use the opportunity to open a Player Account with the intention of abusing Games of Chance, Contests, promotions, rewards, boosts, or any other offer or service available on NAPOLEONDICE. If the Company detects or reasonably suspects any form of abuse, it reserves the right to make the relevant Games of Chance, Contests, promotions, rewards, boosts, or any other offer or service available on NAPOLEONDICE unavailable to such a Player. It may also block, revoke, or terminate the Player Account created or used for this purpose, including the associated Player Accounts, and block, stop, or withhold any related transactions, without the Player being able to claim any rights. The Company also reserves the right to exercise or invoke any other (legal) rights available under applicable law to protect its interests.

Art. 6 - Access

Each Player is responsible for managing their Player Account and the confidentiality of all information entered by the Player, such as, but not limited to, username and password. The Company cannot be held liable at any time and in any way for the use or misuse of the Player's Account and/or the data provided by the Player to the Company or made available on NAPOLEONDICE by a third party, with or without the cooperation or knowledge of the Player.

If the Player becomes aware that another person has access to NAPOLEONDICE using their login credentials or in any other unauthorized manner, or if they become aware of any other misuse by a third party, they must immediately notify the Company by email at the following address: support@napoleongames.be.

The Player is fully and solely responsible for all activity on and with their Player Account. The Company is not responsible for any loss or damage the Player may have suffered due to the unauthorized use of their Player Account by themselves, third parties, or otherwise, regardless of whether the Player was aware of it.

The Company unilaterally reserves the right to deny access to NAPOLEONDICE to any Player who does not comply with these Terms and/or applicable law, in addition to any other remedies provided by applicable law.

In case of dispute, the Player agrees that the registration data and login details or any other information they have provided and which are registered on NAPOLEONDICE will serve as the sole evidence between the parties.

It is also prohibited for Visitors and/or Players to disrupt, obstruct, or hinder access to NAPOLEONDICE in any way or to attempt to do so by any means.

Art. 7 - Participation, Bets, and Winnings

General

If a Player is entitled to participate in a "welcome offer," they can only use it once. This means that the Player can only use such an offer once on NAPOLEONDICE. Furthermore, if the Player has used a welcome offer on NAPOLEONDICE, they will not be able to use it again on NAPOLEONCASINO or NAPOLEONSPORTS.

The Visitor and/or Player commits to refraining from any behavior that could cause damage (including, without being exhaustive, any form of financial, technical, operational, or legal damage) to the Company, its reputation, NAPOLEONDICE, its software, its Games of Chance, its Contests, and other products and services, or to other Visitors/Players, or that could impair the proper and correct functioning of NAPOLEONDICE, its software, and its Games of Chance and Contests and other products and services, as well as anything connected to it, including the Company. The Visitors/Players commit to refraining from any form of manipulation, behavior, actions, or communications in the broadest sense of the word that could endanger, prevent, negatively affect, or in any way harm Visitors/Players, their gaming experience, and their relationship with the Company and NAPOLEONDICE.

It is strictly prohibited to alter or influence the operation of the offered Games of Chance and Contests or other products and services or to attempt to do so by any means, including altering the results, impartiality, or any determining element of a Game of Chance or Contest.

It is also prohibited to hinder, falsify, interrupt, destroy, or limit the normal functioning or features of NAPOLEONDICE, its software, or its Games of Chance and Contests or other products or services, or to offer or (re-)use modified content with computer viruses or any other code or software or any other method or technique.

If the Company reasonably believes that the Visitor/Player has engaged in the aforementioned actions, it reserves the right to immediately terminate or block the Player Account, not to refund the amount credited to the Player's Account, and to prohibit the Visitor/Player from accessing all other internet sites, services, and software offered by NAPOLEONDICE or the Company, all without any recourse of any kind. The Company also reserves the right to exercise or invoke any other (legal) rights available under applicable law to protect its interests.

Games of Chance

Participation in the offered Games of Chance is allowed for Players aged 21 and older.

Participation in a Game occurs, unless the relevant conditions for the particular Game specify otherwise, by wagering a certain amount equal to one of the available Bets. The possible Bets and possible Winnings are listed in the Game Rules. The Bet is freely chosen by the Player for each Game round unless only one bet option is available. Each Bet is immediately debited from the Player's account. If the Player's account balance is insufficient for the chosen Bet, the Player cannot participate in a new Game with that Bet.

At the end of a Game round, the Player is immediately informed of the result, and any Winnings are immediately credited to their Player Account.

If a Game round is interrupted before the end of the round due to the Player's actions, the Player loses the possibility of winning.

If a Game round is interrupted before the end of the round due to a technical problem of any kind, the Player is requested to contact Customer Service immediately. After analyzing the game progression and the technical issue, the Company or the competent third party will prepare a technical report, taking into account the Game Rules, these Terms, or the relevant conditions applicable in that case. The technical report of the progression of this Game round will serve as the sole evidence for calculating winnings or losses and cannot be contested.

If it is found that the progression of one or more Game rounds does not comply with the Game Rules, the relevant conditions specific to the Game, or these Terms, for any reason, NAPOLEONDICE reserves the right, without obligation, to correct the outcome of these Game rounds according to normal gameplay. Any Winnings or losses of the Player during these non-compliant Game round(s) may also be corrected by the Company without prior notice to the Player. The technical report prepared by the Company after analyzing one or more Game rounds that did not comply with the Game Rules, the relevant conditions specific to the Game, or these Terms, for any reason, will serve as the sole evidence for calculating (corrected) winnings or losses and cannot be contested. The Company reserves the right to reclaim funds that were wrongfully awarded to the Player based on the aforementioned technical report and that have been withdrawn by the latter from their Player Account. The Player will immediately comply with such a request.

The progression of a Game round, with or without a financial Bet, from the past cannot be used by the Player as a reference for winnings or losses in future Game rounds.

Art. 8 - Management of the Player Account

Each Player has a Player Account on NAPOLEONDICE, which they created upon registration. The funds deposited into the Player's account can only be used to participate in Games of Chance on NAPOLEONDICE. In accordance with these Terms and legal provisions, the Cash Player can request funds from the Player Account at any time by transferring them to the Player's bank account.

The Company manages the Winnings and losses on the Player Account of the Cash Player through NAPOLEONDICE. The latter expressly mandates the Company to do so. At the start of each Game round, the Player Account of the Cash Player on NAPOLEONDICE is immediately debited by the Company with the Bet. After each Game round, the Player Account of the Cash Player is, if applicable, immediately credited with the Winnings of the Cash Player.

The Company reserves the right to temporarily or permanently, partially or completely, block a Player Account at any time, without prior notice to the Player, to verify the accuracy of any provided information, investigate and prevent fraud, or conduct a review of Game sessions, and in general, to conduct any investigation related to compliance with applicable law, these Terms, the Game Rules, or any other applicable conditions.

The Company has the right to immediately block the account (even during a Game round) in the event of non-compliance or suspicion of non-compliance with applicable law, these Terms, the Game Rules, or any other applicable conditions. In that case, the Company has the right to the amounts in the Player Account of the Cash Player to collect any administrative costs and any damages the Player owes.

Belgian gambling legislation mandates that a maximum deposit limit of €200 per rolling week (a period of 7 consecutive days) must be set on the Player Account ("Deposit Limit"). This legislation allows the Cash Player to increase the stipulated weekly Deposit Limit, provided they are not known as a defaulter with the Central Credit Register for individuals of the National Bank of Belgium ("NBB").

Each Cash Player can request an increase in their weekly Deposit Limit at any time. This request for an increase will take effect after a 72-hour reflection period (i.e., a cool-down period) and

provided that the Cash Player is not known as a defaulter with the Central Credit Register for individuals of the NBB at that time.

The Company reserves the right to impose further restrictions following a request to increase the aforementioned Deposit Limit. These further restrictions will be communicated to the Cash Player at the time of their request to increase the Deposit Limit.

A request to lower a deposit limit will take effect immediately.

Withdrawals from the Player Account are made exclusively via bank transfer. The Company will only transfer the amounts to the European bank account provided by the Cash Player at registration or on the withdrawal request and which the Player guarantees belongs to them. The Company does not systematically check the bank account but only on an ad hoc basis in cases of serious suspicion of non-compliance with applicable law, these Terms, the Game Rules, or any other applicable conditions. The transfer will be executed no later than 5 business days after the Cash Player's request. The Company will always set a minimum amount for withdrawals, except in the case of closing a Player Account on NAPOLEONDICE. If a Cash Player requests the withdrawal of funds deposited into their Player Account without having first been used in a Game of Chance, the Company reserves the right to refuse the withdrawal, among other reasons, to prevent potential anti-money laundering abuses, as long as the full amount (100%) of the funds has not been wagered.

The Company is authorized to conduct security checks or any other verification before executing a transfer. In such cases, the Player must confirm the withdrawal request in writing, with proof of their bank details and a copy (front and back) of their identity card, and if the Company deems it necessary, an official proof of residence issued by the city or municipality where the Player has their official residence. If these details do not match the information provided to the Company, the payment cannot be processed.

In case of any suspicion of identity or bank fraud or any suspicion that the Player has violated applicable law, these Terms, the Game Rules, or any other applicable conditions, the Company reserves the right to block or close a Player Account and/or refuse to process a withdrawal and take all necessary legal actions.

If the Player cannot provide a valid copy of their identity card and, if requested by the Company, cannot provide an official proof of residence issued by the city/municipality whose details (name, first name, date of birth, street name, house number, postal code, city) match the details registered on the Player Account, or any other requested proof, the Company will have the right to block the Player Account and refuse to process the withdrawal. The funds that the Player has expressly requested to be withdrawn will irrevocably become the property of the Company after 3 months from the withdrawal request without the possibility of objection, with the loss of all rights for the Player and their successors, with which each Visitor expressly agrees if the Player does not provide a valid copy of their identity card and, if requested by the Company, an official proof of residence issued by the city/municipality within this 3-month period, matching the details registered on the Player Account or any other requested proof.

The Company reserves the right to close a Player Account, without justification and at its discretion, if there has been no activity on the account for 12 months. The Player will be notified in time by the Company via an email sent to the provided email address that their Player Account will be closed due to inactivity. The funds that the Player has in their account at the time when at least 12 months have passed since the last valid login to the Player Account will irrevocably

become the property of the Company 7 days after the notification, without the possibility of objection, with the loss of all rights for the Visitor and their successors, with which each Player expressly agrees. The Company reserves the right to charge the Cash Player for the costs associated with depositing money into their Player Account on NAPOLEONDICE.

Some of the Company's service providers can limit transfers to a Cash Player's account. Payments with credit cards are not allowed.

The Company reserves the right to communicate with the Player in any way, including informational communication, communication within the framework of an administrative procedure or complaint handling, or the management of the Player Account.

Art. 9 - Customer Service

The Visitor/Player can contact customer service in case of problems, comments, or complaints through various channels:

Customer Service will analyze the Visitor/Player's request, comment, or complaint and try to assist them as soon as possible.

If an immediate solution is not possible, Customer Service will forward the information to the appropriate department for further processing.

Customer Service will contact the Visitor/Player once the relevant department has completed its investigation or if additional information is required.

Customer Service is under no circumstances responsible for the accuracy of the information provided, and the Company cannot be held liable regarding the information provided.

Art. 10 – Exclusion

Time-out:

If the Player feels the need for a period without Games of Chance, they can take a break on NAPOLEONDICE for a period ranging from 24 hours to 6 months, or indefinitely.

Self-exclusion:

If the Player wants to protect themselves, they can choose the self-exclusion option. With this option, it is not possible to reopen the Player Account early.

During self-exclusion, the Player can no longer use the Player Account for any form of Games of Chance. It is also not possible to log in or request to cancel the self-exclusion earlier than the set period.

Closing the Player Account:

If the Player wants to close their Player Account, this function must be used.

Once the closure of the Player Account is confirmed, the Player will be automatically logged out and can no longer perform any of the following activities:

- Log in with the Player Account
- Play Games of Chance
- Deposit or withdraw money from the Player Account

How can the Player Account be reopened?

The Player always has the option to reopen their Player Account. To do this, the Player must follow the steps below:

1. Enter username/email and password.
2. In the pop-up window, the Player will be given the option to reopen their Player Account. Select this option.
3. If the Player chooses to reopen the Player Account, they will need to re-enter their username/email and password for security reasons.
4. The Player can then resume playing.

Unsubscription from the Gaming Commission (KSC):

The Gaming Commission is an independent body with its own procedures. The Company cannot be held accountable for the operation of these procedures.

The Player can unsubscribe from the Belgian Gaming Commission at any time. The Player will then no longer have access to games of chance. The procedure for voluntary unsubscription is described at <https://www.gamingcommission.be/nl/bescherming-van-de-spelers/toegangsverbod/vrijwillige-aanvraag>.

Players with an access ban cannot participate in the Games of Chance offered on NAPOLEONDICE.

Players can lift their access ban by following the procedure provided by the Belgian Gaming Commission. After a waiting period of 3 months from the day the Belgian Gaming Commission receives the request, the Player will have access to games of chance again.

Art. 11 - Intellectual Property

NAPOLEONDICE and the associated domain name and all related rights are the exclusive property of the Company or its partners. These elements constitute creations protected by intellectual property rights. The trademarks, logos, graphic designs, photos, animations, videos, texts, and other distinctive signs on NAPOLEONDICE are the intellectual property of the Company or its partners. Any reproduction, use, or representation thereof without the prior written permission of the Company or its partners is prohibited and subject to legal action.

Creating a hyperlink to the homepage of NAPOLEONDICE, with the exception of any other address, is allowed, provided that this link is not harmful to NAPOLEONDICE and unless otherwise notified by NAPOLEONDICE. Any hyperlink to an internal page of NAPOLEONDICE is prohibited unless prior written permission is obtained from the Company or its partners.

Art. 12 - Social Media

The Company uses, within the allowed legal framework, social media, including but not limited to:

All messages displayed via social media channels are purely informational and cannot be considered binding towards NAPOLEONDICE.

The Company cannot be held liable for all messages appearing on social media channels.

Each person agrees, as far as the legal framework allows any expressions, to respect the basic rules of good conduct, courtesy, and politeness when using social media in the broadest sense and must, in particular:

- Remain courteous and friendly,
- Avoid personal attacks.

Visitors are expressly prohibited from spreading, propagating, or contributing to the dissemination of messages with a hateful, racist, anti-Semitic, xenophobic, homophobic, defamatory character, or that are harmful to public order and morals or, more generally, degrading or insulting messages on any medium that relate to NAPOLEONDICE, the Company, or its Visitors/Players.

Messages that are contrary to the spirit of NAPOLEONDICE or the Company, such as but not limited to messages containing a particular political or religious stance or opinion, unwanted, excessive, or inappropriate messages, messages that mislead other Visitors/Players about the game rules, or by assuming the name of other persons and, in particular, by pretending to be an employee, collaborator, or partner of the Company are also prohibited on social media.

Moreover, it is forbidden for the Visitor/Player to impersonate another Visitor/Player or to communicate under a false name, false capacity, or false pseudonym or to lie about their age.

NAPOLEONDICE reserves the right to remove messages on its social media channels that are contrary to these provisions or to the applicable legislation.

The Company can in no case be held liable for the content, particularly for the illegal nature of the content, concerning the applicable legislation, any loss, or damage resulting from the use of content posted and spread via social media. In the event that the Company's liability is invoked due to a breach by the Visitor/Player of their obligations under these Terms or the legal and regulatory provisions, the Company reserves the right to prosecute the Visitor/Player.

Art. 13 - Live Casino

The Live Casino is provided and managed by the Company.

The Company, the software provider, and the player application provider, as well as their parent/subsidiary companies and other affiliated companies, are not liable in any way, including

negligence, for direct, indirect, incidental, special, or consequential damages that may arise from the use of or inability to use the Live Casino, associated applications, and/or other materials. The Player indemnifies the Company, the software provider, the other suppliers of the Company, the employees, staff, directors, licensees, distributors, resellers, affiliated companies, subsidiaries, advertising and other agencies, media partners, agents, and retailers from all costs, expenses, liabilities, and damages that may result from the following actions: (i) access, use, and reuse of the Live Casino and the applications of the Live Casino, (ii) participation in the Live Casino, and (iii) acceptance of any prize. If the Visitor is not satisfied with the service related to the Live Casino, they can only stop using the Live Casino to address this.

Art. 14 - Liability

The information on NAPOLEONDICE is regularly updated and checked. However, the Company cannot be held liable for the unlawful use that Visitors/Players make, directly or indirectly, of such information, or any other unlawful actions that violate applicable law, these Terms, the Game Rules, or any other applicable conditions. The Company disclaims all liability in this regard and offers no guarantee concerning the services provided through NAPOLEONDICE. The Company also cannot guarantee the permanent availability of all NAPOLEONDICE functions without errors or interruptions, the immediate correction of errors, or the total absence of viruses or other harmful elements on NAPOLEONDICE and the infrastructure on which the services are provided. There may be temporary limitations due to technical problems such as telecommunication interruptions, program errors, or material issues, etc. The Company cannot be held liable for loss or damage (direct, indirect, movable, or immovable) resulting from these temporary limitations or in connection with the use of NAPOLEONDICE or the inability to use NAPOLEONDICE services. Visitors/Players are responsible for the correct functioning and upgrades of their hardware, software, and internet access.

The Company reserves the right to modify, suspend, or terminate one or more of the Games of Chance, including the Game Rules or other associated conditions, Contests, or other services offered on NAPOLEONDICE at any time and without prior notice. The Company cannot be held liable in such cases, so Players cannot claim any compensation.

Without prejudice to any other provision in these Terms and to the extent permitted by applicable law, the Company will never be liable for any indirect, incidental, or other forms of consequential damages towards the Visitor/Player.

To the extent necessary and without prejudice to any other provision in these Terms, the Company reserves all rights, including the right to claim damages and file a criminal complaint,

if it suspects or knows that a Visitor/Player is violating applicable law, these Terms, the Game Rules, or any other applicable conditions, or generally causing harm to the Company.

For the avoidance of doubt and within the limits of the law, the Visitor/Player agrees that compensation for damages caused by a contractual breach by an auxiliary person of the Company (including personnel, employees, directors, officers, agents, representatives, consultants, suppliers, (sub)contractors, successors, and assignees of the Company) (i) can only be claimed based on a contractual claim against the Company in accordance with the liability provisions of these General Terms and Conditions; (ii) does not entitle the Visitor/Player to make an extra-contractual claim against the Company; and (iii) does not entitle the Visitor/Player to make an extra-contractual claim against an auxiliary person of the Company, even if the act or omission that caused the damage is also a tort.

For the avoidance of doubt and within the limits of the law, the Visitor/Player agrees that the Company cannot be held liable for any tort.

Art. 15 - Nullity of a Clause

The nullity, lapse, or unenforceability of all or part of these General Terms and Conditions never leads to the nullity of these General Terms and Conditions in their entirety. The wholly or partially void, lapsed, or unenforceable provision is presumed not to have been written. The Company undertakes to replace this provision with another provision that fulfills the same function to the extent possible. In the event of a dispute, the Company and the Visitor/Player will interpret and apply the wholly or partially void, lapsed, or unenforceable provision in a manner as close as possible to such provision, considering the intentions of such provision.

Art. 16 - No Waiver

The failure to assert a right or apply a sanction by the Company, or the failure to do so promptly, does not imply a waiver of such right. The Company will always have the right to exercise its rights under this agreement.

Art. 17 – Applicable Law & Competent Courts

Any dispute, whether contractual or extra-contractual, regarding the Terms, NAPOLEONDICE, its use, or otherwise, is exclusively governed by Belgian law. If the parties involved cannot reach an amicable settlement, the dispute will be submitted to the courts where the Company has its registered office, which have exclusive jurisdiction in the matter.

If these Terms need to be translated into another language, the Dutch version will prevail in case of conflict between the translation and the Dutch version.
